# Ninja Cyborg Studio Tattoo Aftercare Instructions

Proper healing is key to maintaining your new tattoo. Please follow the instructions below based on the type of bandage used. If you have any questions, contact your artist or the studio directly.

## **For Transparent Dressings**

- Leave bandages on for a minimum of 24 hours and up to 3-5 days.
- · If the bandage is filled with fluid, lifting at the edges, or irritating the skin, you may remove it early.
- Do not leave the bandage on for more than 5 days.
- To remove: Run warm water over the bandage to loosen adhesive (a shower is ideal). Gently pull from one corner backward, close to the skin never directly away.

DO NOT re-bandage or reseal your tattoo after removal. Lotion / Poly twice a day.

### For Non-Adhesive Bandages

- Leave the bandage on overnight or for up to 24 hours after your tattoo.
- To remove: Gently peel off. If stuck, soak it in the shower until it loosens.
  - DO NOT re-bandage or reseal your tattoo after removal.
- Wash your tattoo twice daily with non-scented soap.
- Apply a thin layer of green Polysporin or non-scented lotion (e.g. Aveeno) twice a day.
- · LESS IS MORE! Avoid over-applying lotion.

## **Healing Timeline**

- First few days: Tattoo may leak ink or plasma wear old, dark clothing.
- First two weeks: Tattoo may scab, itch, and peel. DO NOT pick or scratch.

Four weeks: Tattoo takes up to 4 weeks to fully heal.

- No soaking: Avoid rivers, lakes, pools, hot tubs, or baths.
- No sun: Keep your tattoo out of direct sunlight and tanning beds.
  - After 4 weeks: Apply SPF 45 or higher to protect your tattoo.

#### Do & Don't List

#### DO:

- Wash hands before touching your tattoo
  - Use clean sheets and towels
  - Follow your artist's advice

#### DON'T:

- · Re-bandage your tattoo
- Apply alcohol, peroxide, or petroleum jelly
  - Let pets lick or touch your tattoo
